Considerations and tips

When choosing windows and doors for your remodeling project, it's helpful to ask yourself some specific questions that can clarify the features you want and the requirements your selection must meet. That's why we've provided a few things for you to consider during the planning stages of your project.

What is the architecture of your home (e.g., traditional, contemporary, Old World or Craftsman)?

Question 1 TIPS

JELD-WEN creates a variety of designs and options to enhance and complement any architectural style. For example, windows with simulated divided lites (SDL) are appropriate for traditional styles, whereas windows without any divided lites appear more modern. Arched doors and windows, doors with vertical planked designs, and doors with metal straps and clavos all add to the charm of Old World homes, while Craftsman homes often call for windows and doors with clean lines and simple profiles.

Are there any items your windows and doors should match, such as cabinetry or moulding?

Question 2 TIPS

You can stain the interior of your entry doors, wood windows and interior doors to match your moulding and millwork for a unified look in your home. To help achieve optimal design consistency, select JELD-WEN® windows and doors with matching wood species.

Do you want to enhance your windows or doors with options or custom features?

Question 3 TIPS

Choosing options for your windows and doors helps you personalize them, and taking advantage of custom capabilities lets you achieve a truly one-of-a-kind look. JELD-WEN provides a vast array of options, from color finishes and divided lite patterns for windows to decorative glass and metal accents for exterior doors. We can also create custom wood windows, wood exterior doors and custom carved medium density fiberboard (MDF) interior doors in nearly any design you have in mind.

Question 4 TIPS

There's a window and door for any budget, and costs can vary greatly depending on size, material type and options. For exterior doors, prices are generally lowest for steel doors, followed by composite, and wood or custom fiberglass are the most expensive. In terms of windows, aluminum is the most affordable, then vinyl, and finally metal-clad-wood. However, remember that overall value should be considered, rather than the price alone. For example, when you invest in our ENERGY STAR® qualified windows and doors, you'll be rewarded with potential tax credits and reduced heating and cooling bills. In fact, on an average home you can save between \$150 and \$340* annually by replacing single-pane windows with dual-pane ENERGY STAR qualified windows.

Question 5 TIPS

If you're planning to sell your home, you can considerably increase your home's resale value by replacing your windows and doors. For instance, selecting a new JELD-WEN® Premium Wood exterior door with coordinating sidelights can raise your home's perceived value. On average, you can also recover over 100 percent of your costs over time with new, energy efficient windows, such as those with Low-E glass.*

Question 6 TIPS

Generally, remodeling is defined as a project that involves changing an existing space within your home. Additions, which involve adding one or more new spaces, are more like new construction, and they offer greater size and architectural flexibility. In either case, you can count on JELD-WEN to meet your needs. All our windows and doors are appropriate for additions, and we offer a wide range of products specifically for remodeling projects, such as our double-hung replacement kits.

Starting out smart

Window and door measuring and installation overview

Window measurements

Before selecting your windows, take a few measurements (as outlined below) to ensure the proper fit. When you're ready to install JELD-WEN® windows, please refer to the installation instructions on the window label, or visit www.jeld-wen.com/resources.

The four basic steps

1. Determine if the rough opening or existing window frames are square, level and plumb. If they are not, contact a professional to make corrections. (See Fig. 1.)

Square: Measure the diagonals of the window opening. Measurements must be within 1/4" for windows greater than 20 sq. ft. (e.g., 4' x 5'). For windows equal to or smaller than 20 sq. ft., measurements must be within 1/8".

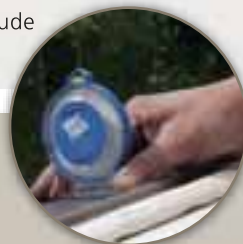
Level and plumb: First, place a level against the window opening jambs. Then determine if the plane of the window is vertical (plumb) by measuring the edge of the jamb, rather than the inside surface of the jamb. The opening cannot be more than 1/8" out-of-level or plumb.

2. Take three measurements for both height and width. (See worksheet and Fig. 2 to the right.) If you're installing replacement sash for double-hung windows, also use an angle finder (available at most hardware stores) to verify the sill angle is the standard 14°. If not, you must specify the angle when ordering.

3. Report the smallest measurement when ordering. Please note, all three measurements should be within 1/8". If not, contact a professional to determine how to correct.

4. For wood replacement windows include a jamb depth measurement.

Installing new doors: slabs vs. prehung

If the door frames in your home are still in good condition, all you may need to replace are the door slabs (or blanks). However, if the frames are worn or rotting, choose prehung door systems, which come with hinges and are pre-bored for a standard lockset. Prehung doors are also easier to install. Please refer to the general installation tips below.

Door slabs

- Measure your current door slab or door opening dimensions.
- Order a JELD-WEN door slab that matches these dimensions (NOTE: **Wood** door slabs can be trimmed 1/4" on each side, 1/2" on top and 1/2" on bottom to fit the dimensions of your current door frame).
- You may also need to prep the door for hinges and hardware, mortising the edge for hinges and boring the door for the lockset.

Prehung door measurements

Door jamb width:

- Measure width of existing door jamb between the inside edges of the casing. (See Fig. 3.)
- Add 1/2" to 3/4".
- Report the measurement here: _____

Door jamb height:

- Measure height of existing door jamb between the inside edges of the casing. (See Fig. 3.)
- Add 1/2".
- Report the measurement here: _____

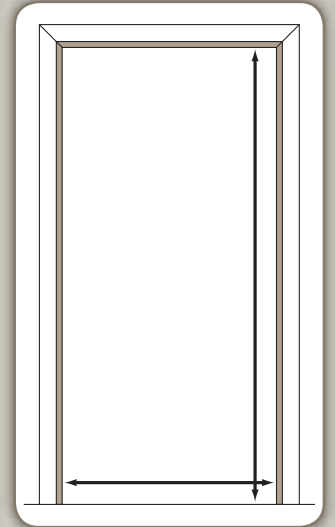

Prehung door systems

- Measure the height and width of the existing door jamb (see worksheet to the right), or the rough opening between the wall studs.
- Measure the thickness of the wall to determine the frame width needed.
- Select the JELD-WEN® prehung door that best fits your measurements.

- Determine the door handing you need. Door handing refers to the swing of the door. Prehung doors are specified as left-hand or right-hand doors which designates hinging and the swing of the door. (See Fig. 4 and 5.)
- To determine the door's swing (left or right), face the closed door from the outside (the side where the hinges cannot be seen). Then open the door. If the door swings away from you to your left, it is a left-hand swing door. If the door swings away from you to the right, it is a right-hand swing door.

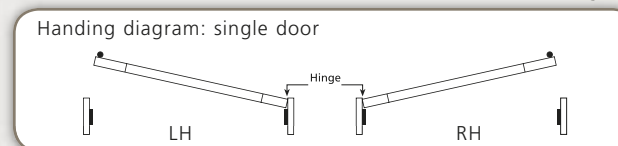
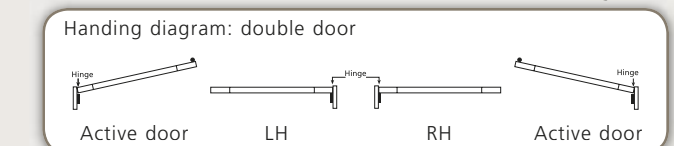

Getting the measurements right

To ensure your new windows are weathertight, it's crucial to obtain the correct measurements. Therefore, you may want to consider professional assistance.

For additions/new construction:

- Measure width and height of rough opening 6" from each corner and at the center.
- Report the smallest measurement here: _____ (This is your rough opening size.)

For replacement (fully removing an existing window):

- Measure width and height from the outside frame edge to outside frame edge, 6" from each corner and at the center. (NOTE: If the existing frame has a sloping sill, seek professional assistance or call JELD-WEN customer service at 800.JELD-WEN.)
- Report the smallest measurement here: _____ (This is your rough opening size.)

For replacement (installing a window in an existing frame):

- Measure width and height of existing rough opening 6" from each corner and at the center.
- Report the smallest measurement here: _____ (This is your rough opening size.)

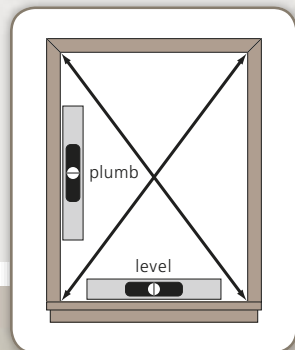

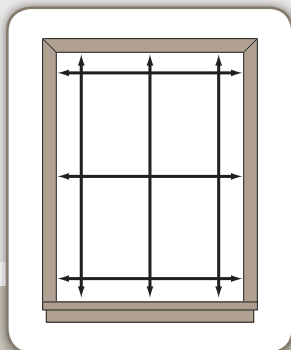

Maintenance factors

Climate

It's important to remember that every climate has its own benefits and challenges. Climate is also a deciding factor in how much maintenance your windows and doors will require. We've provided the following chart to help you select appropriate products for your climate.

Energy efficiency

JELD-WEN® wood windows and Courtyard Collection steel exterior doors come standard with energy efficient Low-E glass that helps you save money on your heating and cooling bills and reduces fading due to UV exposure. Low-E glass is also an affordable option for JELD-WEN vinyl and aluminum windows and Premium Wood doors. With the proper glass options, your JELD-WEN windows and doors will meet ENERGY STAR® requirements. JELD-WEN has been an ENERGY STAR partner since 1998, and was honored as a 2003 ENERGY STAR "Partner of the Year."

Exposures: windows and patio doors

The placement of windows and patio doors on certain walls can determine the kind of natural light that enters into your home, or even the temperature inside your home. South- and east-facing windows bring in bright, golden light. North-facing windows usher in cooler, muted light. And west-facing windows let in abundant direct sunlight, as well as the beauty of sunsets. Consider that windows on south-, southwest-, southeast- or west-facing walls may be more susceptible to heat gain.



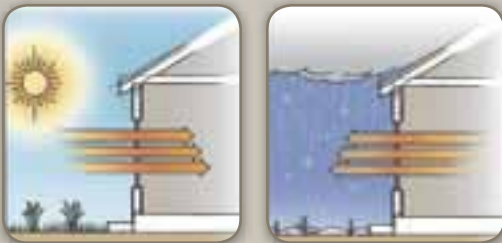
Exposures: exterior doors

For exterior doors, it's imperative to consider exposure if you select a wood door. To adequately protect the door and extend its life, you'll have to take into account your climate and the direction the door will be facing. Then you must determine the amount of overhang needed to protect the door from the elements, which can be obtained by following a simple formula: $Y=1/2X$ (in most cases). For example, if the measurement from the base of your door to the bottom of your overhang is ten feet, then the overhang should be a minimum of five feet deep.



X = Distance from the bottom of door to base of overhang.

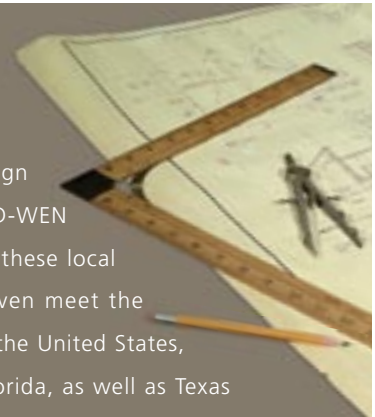
Y = The amount of overhang protection required.



In contrast, clear glass has low resistance to heat flow.

Building codes

Building codes are published ordinances that will regulate many aspects of your project, such as design loads, opening widths and material selection. JELD-WEN windows and doors are designed and tested with these local building codes in mind. Many of our products even meet the toughest standards for hurricane-prone regions in the United States, including Miami-Dade and Broward counties in Florida, as well as Texas and North Carolina.

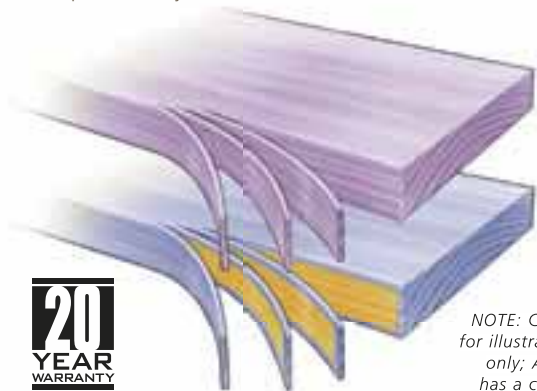

Window styles

Awning

An awning window is appropriate for many architectural styles, and it looks intriguing when grouped with other window types. It is hinged at the top and opens from the bottom in an outward swing.

Bay

This type of window is ideal for traditional or Victorian architecture, and increases the sense of openness in any room. A bay window is composed of three or more individual units. The center unit is parallel to the exterior wall with side or flanking units aligned at 30- or 45-degree angles.

Bow

A bow window subtly increases interior spaces by extending outward to create the illusion of a rounded exterior wall. It consists of a series of four or more (commonly five) adjoining window units that are installed on a radius from the wall of the building.

Casement

A casement window perfectly complements the simplicity of modern design, while also providing maximum ventilation. This type of window is hinged on either side so the sash opens outward, to the right or left, in a swinging motion.

Double-Hung

This window is best suited to traditional architectural styles. Double-hung windows feature an upper and lower sash that slide vertically past each other in a single frame. Many double-hung windows feature sash that tilt in for convenient cleaning. We also offer a range of double-hung replacement windows, which are perfect for remodeling projects.

Geometric and Radius

This type of window allows you to showcase beautiful views and create intriguing window arrangements with other window types. It has a fixed (non-operative) sash and it's available in a variety of shapes and sizes. Please note, this style may also be referred to as *custom picture*.

Single-Hung

A single-hung window provides a classic appearance to any home. It features a stationary top sash and a bottom sash that slides vertically. We offer single-hung tilt windows with sash that tilt inside your home, as well as single-hung, side-load windows with removable sash. Both are designed for easy cleaning.

Slider

Each of our slider windows features clean lines for a streamlined look. This type of window has one stationary sash and one sash that slides to the right or left horizontally in grooves or tracks. Please note, this style may also be referred to as *horizontal sliding* or *horizontal gliding*.

Sliding Patio Door

This type of door is perfect for nearly any patio or deck. It opens by sliding along horizontal tracks at the head and/or sill. Our sliding patio doors are available in two-, three- and four-panel designs.

Swinging Patio Door

Add an element of drama to your home, on either a small or grand scale, with a swinging patio door. These doors are available with one, two or more panels that swing either out or in on side hinges. This includes French doors, which open in the middle with no center mullion.

Transom

Bring additional visual interest to your home with a transom. This type of window is set above another window or a door. It can be either stationary or operational.

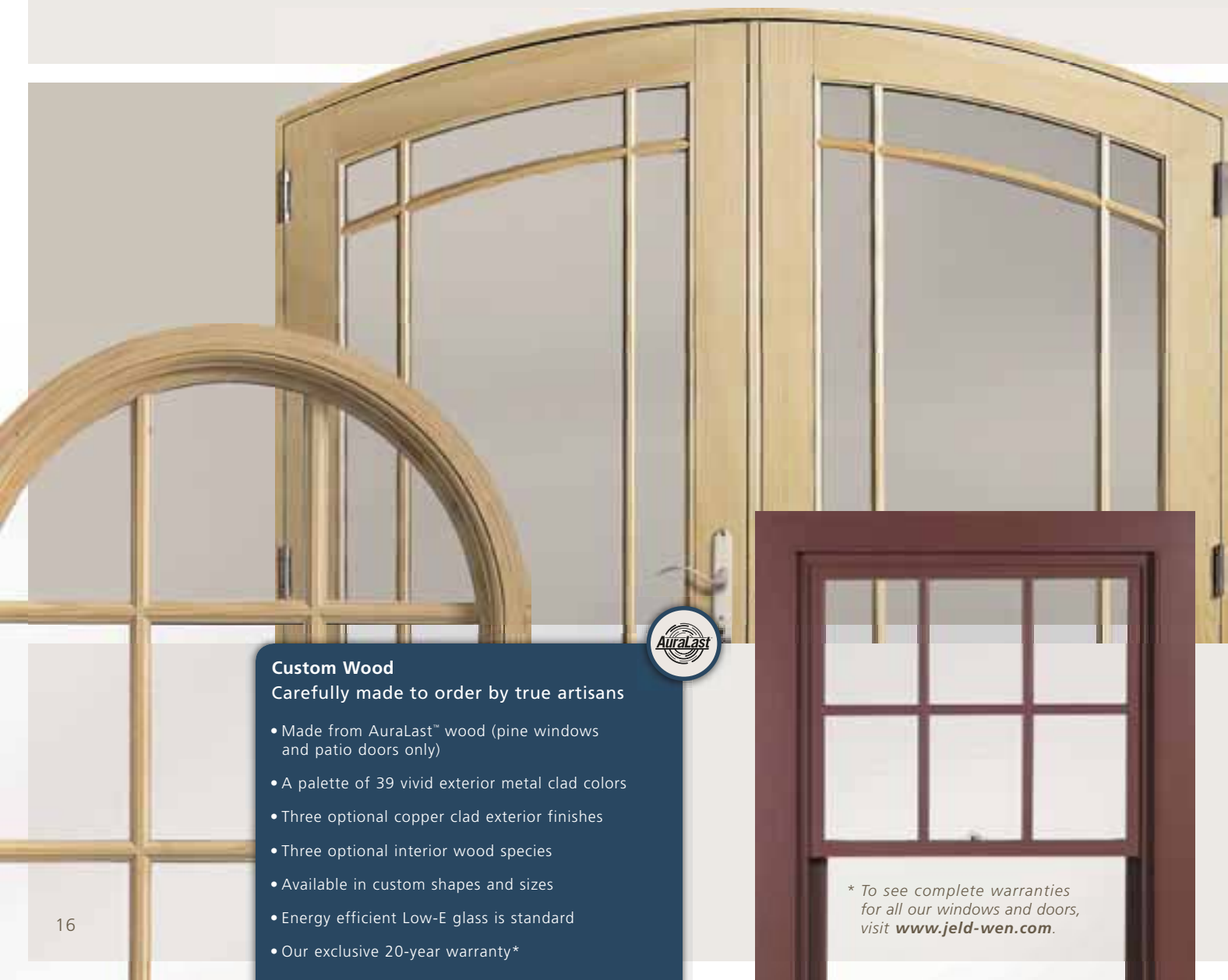
