

Commonly used for traffic signs and concrete formwork industries, Medium Density Overlay (MDO) is engineered plywood with a phenolic resin treated fiber applied to both faces. Our WaterBarrier technology uses the phenolic-impregnated face of MDO to create an extremely durable and smooth finish that is easy to paint. Additionally, MDO is specifically rated for exterior use, which means your door is safe from harsh elements, insects, or other outdoor hazards. It's a perfect choice when needing additional protection for exterior doors in tough environments.
